CHAPTER III

METHODOLOGY

In this chapter, the study aimed to present the design, participants, and context of the study, the instrument used, data collection methods, and data analysis procedures.

3.1 Research Design

The study employed a mixed-method sequential explanatory design to collect and analyze quantitative data. Subsequently, qualitative data was utilized to elucidate or expand upon the findings of the quantitative data (Cresswell, 2017). The designs were formulated, and notation was incorporated to assist the reader in comprehending the designs; challenges to working with the designs arose. The explanatory sequential mixed method is one in which the researcher conducted quantitative research, analyzed the results, and then expanded on the findings by explaining them in more detail through qualitative research. It was considered explanatory because the initial quantitative data results were further elucidated with the qualitative data (Cresswell, 2017).

3.2 Participants and Context of the Study

The participants of this study were 8 EFL students majoring in English Education who were enrolled in 2019. The recruitment was based on inclusion criteria (Koltovskaia, 2020), such as the students being L2 learners of English, taking a writing course in which they were required to produce a multiple-draft assignment, and having used Grammarly before. The following participants had passed the inclusion criteria.

3.3 Instrumentations

The researcher had used a closed-ended questionnaire (Krosnick, 2018), essay documents, and reflections ((Nguyen, Fernandez, Karsenti, & Charlin, 2014) to gather the data. The closed-ended questionnaire was distributed via WhatsApp using a Google Form to elicit the students' perceptions of using Grammarly. Google Form reduced the challenge of participants needing to be familiar with the interface, as it was highly intuitive (Opara, Spangsdorf, & Ryan, 2021). The instruments were applied in an online way using the WhatsApp application. The main reason was that participants were quick to fill in and answer the questions and facilitated the researcher in finding and coding the data. The spreading of these instruments was conducted for a myriad of procedures; firstly, the questionnaire sheet in Google Form was spread through WhatsApp one by one. Meanwhile, the essay task

documents were taken from the students who had completed writing courses in which they were required to produce a multiple-draft assignment and were analyzed to get the data.

The reflection consisted of students' answers or responses to questions about using Grammarly in proofreading essay tasks. Various disciplines, including education, professional development, and psychology, often used reflection to reorganize knowledge and emotional orientation to achieve further insight (Moon, 2006). The reflective process made people think critically, which was important because it helped create new relationships between initial knowledge and what was obtained. It made writing reflection more effective (Creswell & Creswell, 2018). The outcome from the reflection could be something expected or unexpected due to the complicated and ill-structured ideas (Moon, 2006). Therefore, from the reflection, we could gather many ideas or responses from the students that would enrich the data.

3.4. Data Collection

Data on the students' perceptions were collected using a questionnaire (Krosnick, 2018). The questionnaire consisted of 9 statements constructed as Likert scales with four options: strongly agree, agree, disagree, and strongly disagree. Four options were used to pose a specific tendency so that the students' responses could be identified clearly. The nine statements were intended to know the students' perception of two aspects: the practicality of Grammarly use (3 statements) and the Grammarly feedback (6 statements). Then, the researcher spread the reflections to students who were chosen randomly. The researcher took the student's essay task

documents using WhatsApp for the documentation. The results of the questionnaire were supported and explained by the reflection data. Following the collection of data, the researcher interpreted the analytic results. Lastly, the researcher explained the conclusion reached due to the data analysis.

3.5. Data Analysis

Data were analyzed based on the students' responses to each statement. This study applied descriptive statistics using Fisher and Marshall (2009) and inferential statistics (Asadoorian & Kantarelis, 2005). A descriptive statistic was used to see the frequency and percentage of the students; responses were categorized into positive or agree, including "strongly agree" and "agree" responses, and negative or disagree, including "disagree" and "strongly disagree" responses. Fisher and Marshall (2009) also stated that descriptive statistics are a helpful strategy that allows us to reduce participant data into a summary number, thus making meaning from the results. At the design stage of the research project, the researcher had to consider the data required to adequately address the research question and recognize the respective measurement levels. Meanwhile, inferential statistics were used to infer from the sample group generalizations that could be applied to a wider population.

The methods of this data analysis were conducted for a myriad of procedures. Initially, descriptive statistics methods were employed to capture the essential features from sample data using tables, charts, and graphs. Subsequently, the sampling distributions were described, paving the way for inferential statistics, which allowed conclusions about the entire population from which the sample was drawn (Stapor, 2020).

For the students' reflection, the gathered data was analyzed using the technique of analyzing data by Miles, Huberman, and Saldana (2014). To begin with, in data condensation, the researcher decided which data chunks to code and which to pull out. After that, data was summarized, highlighted, and were created into groups and partitioned (categorized), and also took note of several essential answers (coded) to obtain similar perceptions from the students. Miles et al. (2014) noted that data condensation included writing summaries, coding, developing themes, generating categories, and writing analytic memos. This stage of analysis was also supported by Jackson et al. (2007), who stated that qualitative content analysis involved interpreting, theorizing, or making sense of data by first breaking it down into segments that could be categorized and encoded and then building patterns for the entire data set by linking categories to each other. As Saldana (2016) concluded, a code was a word or short phrase that symbolically assigned a summative, salient, essence-capturing, and evocative attribute for a portion of language-based or visual data. The example of data coding is as follows:
