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ABSTRACT

This study investigates EFL preservice teachers' perceptions of reflective teaching journal writing use. Data were collected from preservice teachers' reflections. This research involved 10 English education major students. The result of this study revealed that most of the preservice teachers perceived reflective journal writing as beneficial. Reflective teaching journal writing helped them realize and evaluate their shortcomings as EFL preservice teachers during their field teaching practice.
